

Statement of Public Compliance

- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland is committed to complying with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a meeting of the Board of Directors.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland regularly monitors compliance with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and compliance reports are received regularly by the Board of Directors.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland considers the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* when planning all fundraising activity.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*. Feedback is recorded for review by the Deputy Director, the Director and Board of Directors. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
- The Migrant Rights Centre Ireland is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
